



Memo on the Bilateral Meeting between the State Food and Drug Administration of the People's Republic of China and the Brazilian Health Surveillance Agency

Within the framework of the Complementary Agreement to the Agreement of Scientific and Technological Cooperation signed in Beijing on 24th of May, 2004 between the Government of the People's Republic of China and the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil, the State Food and Drug Administration, People's Republic of China and the Brazilian Health Surveillance Agency (hereinafter referred as Executing Agencies) met in Brasilia on June 4, 2010.

During the bilateral meeting, Both Executing Agencies expressed their willingness to establish a routine dialogue mechanism in order to safeguard the public health of both countries. The Executing Agencies agree to promote the exchange of information and expertise in the following areas:





- 1. the GMP Inspection / Sanitary Inspection on the Pharmaceutical and Medical Device Manufacturers in both China and Brazil;
- 2. the Post-Market Surveillance on Pharmaceuticals and Medical Devices;
- 3. the Quality Control and Registration on Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients;
- 4. the Supervision on the Advertisement of Pharmaceuticals;
- 5. Pharmacopeia.
