
After a very productive discussion during the period of March 15th to 18th, 2011 and recognizing the importance of the joint work between the two institutions to contribute to health promotion of both countries, China State Food and Drug Administration (SFDA) and Brazilian Health Surveillance Agency (ANVISA) have agreed to strengthen the cooperation in following aspects:

1. To provide support to inspection activities carried out by inspectors from the other party on its own land, send out inspectors to join the inspection team under request, and share inspection information;
2. To provide support on identifying Market Authorization Certificate, GMP certificate under the request of the other party;
3. Taking into account the mutual interest of ANVISA and SFDA to integrate the Pharmaceutical Inspection Cooperation Scheme, both institutions will cooperate and share information and experience to contribute to reach the PIC/S approval;
4. Promote information sharing in laws and regulations, industries, and products;
5. Promote cooperation between national laboratories, pharmacopeia commissions, and local health authorities.

This Memorandum of Meeting is signed in Beijing on March 18th, 2011, in three originals each in Chinese, Portuguese, and English languages, all three texts being equally authentic. In case any misinterpretation arises, the English version shall prevail.


