

**Memorandum of Understanding
between
the Brazilian Health Surveillance Agency
and
the Ministry of Health of the State of Israel
on
Regulatory Cooperation of
Pharmaceuticals, Cosmetics, Medical Devices and Food Safety**

The Brazilian Health Surveillance Agency (hereinafter referred to as "ANVISA") of Brazil and the Ministry of Health (hereinafter referred to as "MOH") of the State of Israel (together referred to as "the Participants");

Desiring to further enhance regulatory cooperation through amicable negotiations between the Participants;

Within the framework of the Agreement between the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil and the Government of the State of Israel on Cooperation in the Fields of Health and Medicine, signed in Jerusalem on June 19 2006;

Have reached the following understandings:

Article I

Purpose

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is to establish a mechanism of cooperation under which the Participants, in accordance with their respective laws, regulations and procedures, and on the basis of equality and reciprocity, facilitate regulatory cooperation in the fields of Pharmaceuticals, Cosmetics, Medical Devices and Food Safety.

Article II

Areas of Cooperation

The main areas of regulatory cooperation between the Participants are included in the framework of the following fields:

- i. The Pharmaceutical & Cosmetics Regulations
- ii. The Medical Devices Regulation
- iii. The Food Safety Regulation

These areas are not exhaustive and are not intended to exclude other areas from cooperation.

Article III
Cooperation Activities

Under the framework of this MOU, the Participants may arrange:

- senior official meetings
- exchange of visits at working level
- exchange of experts and training of staff for study and consultation purposes,
- exchange of information on conferences, seminars and other events organized in both Countries.
- other specific activities through designated contact points.
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Article IV
Expenditure

The Participants will cover their own costs for activities under this MOU. In principle, each Participant is responsible for the expenses of its staff on any relevant visits.

Article V
Confidentiality

All aspects of confidentiality shall be dealt with according to article 9 of the Agreement between the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil and the Government of the State of Israel on Cooperation in the Fields of Health and Medicine, signed in Jerusalem on June 19 2006;

Article VI
Intellectual Property

- a) Each Participant shall ensure legal means for the protection of intellectual property rights of all materials obtained in the framework of this MOU, in accordance with the national legislations of the Participants.
- b) Intellectual Property Rights which shall result from joint activity in pursuance to this MOU shall be allocated and governed in accordance with separate agreements to be made on a case by case basis.

Article VII
Settlement of Disputes

Any dispute or differences between the Participants concerning the application or interpretation of the provisions of this MOU shall be settled amicably by direct consultation between the Participants.


Article VIII
Supplementary Provisions

All activities undertaken pursuant to this MOU shall be subject to the availability of funds.


This MOU shall come into effect on the date of its signature.
This MOU will remain in effect for a period of five (5) years, unless either Participant gives notice of termination in writing to the other, through diplomatic channels, six (6) months prior to the intended date of expiration. The termination of this MOU shall not affect any program undertaken prior to the termination of this MOU, unless otherwise agreed upon by the Participants.

Any amendments to this MOU shall be made by mutual consent of the Participants in writing and will come into effect with the same procedures specified in this article.

Done in Tel-Aviv on the 25th day of the month of March 2015, which corresponds to the 5 day of Nissan 5775 of the Hebrew Calendar, in two original copies in the English language, both being equally authentic.
